P.E. KIT Reception-Year 6

Our P.E. Kit is the same for both boys and girls and consists of the following: Red T-shirt Black shorts or jogging bottoms (no leggings or cycling shorts) Black zipped jacket (no logos) Black pumps (indoors) / Velcro <u>only</u> trainers (outdoors) These should also be marked with the child's name and kept in a small draw-string bag.

Jewellery

A wristwatch is acceptable from Year 2 upwards (no smart watches), which must be removed before any P.E lessons.

Stud earrings only – these must be taken out for P.E. lessons. If your child is not able to take out their own earrings, these must be taken out in the morning, prior to coming into School.

We ask if you wish to get your child's ears pierced, you do so at the start of the summer holidays so they can be removed in September for school.

<u>Hair</u>

Boys and girls with hair reaching shoulder length must tie it back with a band in school colours (red or black). If your child attends school with their hair loose they will be given an elastic band to tie hair up with. Any hair accessory worn by your child should be discrete and either red or black. Hairstyles which are deemed to be extreme are not permitted e.g. lines or patterns shaven into the hair.

Footwear

Children should also wear sensible black footwear – no fashion shoes and no high heels. Velcro shoes are recommended for children in the Early Years (Nursery and Reception), including Velcro trainers for P.E. <u>Children should only wear laces if they are able to tie</u> <u>them themselves</u>.

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with the child's name.



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
