## AIMING HIGH

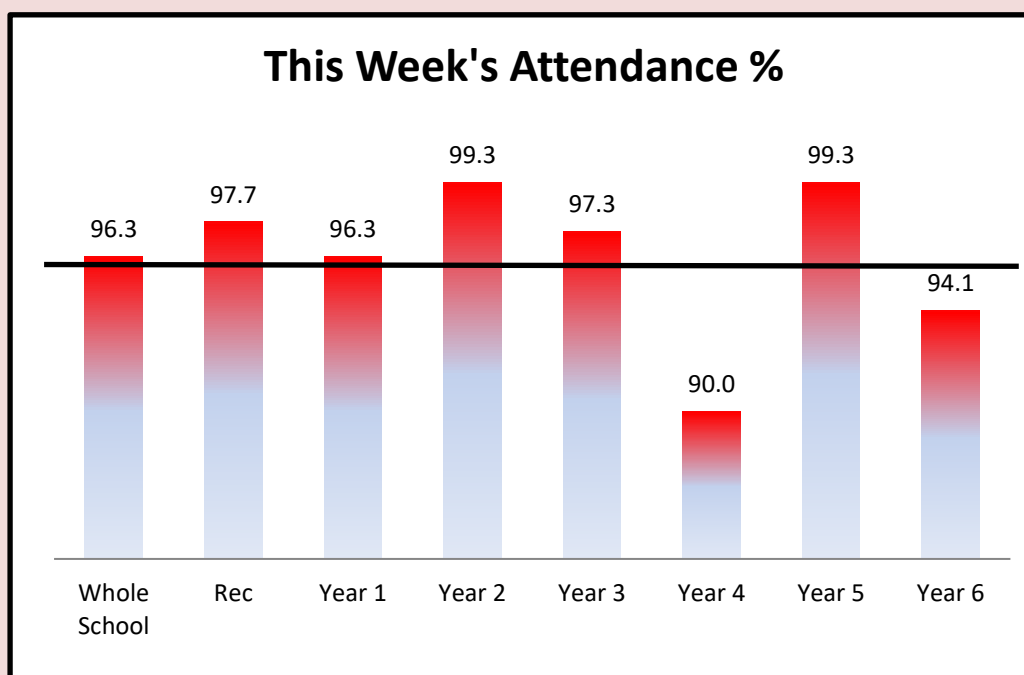
