SCHOOL REPORT

School reports were due to be sent home on Friday but due to staffing absence we have delayed them until this Wednesday. Can we please ask that all parents return the response slip to acknowledge receipt of their child's report. Comments are always welcomed so please do add them onto slip.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Uniform for September remains the same as our current regulations. The only new aspect is the addition of the new school logo and the new supplier for all your uniform needs. Either logo is perfectly acceptable next year – there is no need to buy new logoed uniform.

We still have stock of PE kit, jumpers and cardigans with the old logo on that Mrs Jones is selling at a greatly reduced price (50% off) for next year so if you are stocking up for September – come and grab a bargain.

Our new uniform supplier (**Sefton Schoolwear**) will be selling PE kits, jumpers, cardigans, school ties, book bags, caps and water bottles.

We will be strict with our uniform from September as some children have started coming into school with expensive, branded tops with large logos, etc. These are not acceptable for school uniform. For PE, **PURE PLAIN BLACK hoody and joggers** are allowed so please ensure these are available for September. A separate letter will follow setting out our uniform expectations.

SPORTS DAY

As always, children are to come to school in their PE kit on the Sports Day. We advise ALL children to have applied sun cream before school, just in case the sun is cracking the flags – we never really know until the day itself. Children will also need a water bottle in school that they can take with them onto the field.

Double gates will be opened when the event has finished and children can then be collected and taken home.
