Dear Parents

As we are now in our final week, I am just writing with regards to the end of term arrangements, school uniform and the first days back in September.

## **UNIFORM:**

As you'll all be aware, new uniform can be purchased from Sefton Schoolwear at 19 Dover Road, Maghull.

Attached with this letter is the full uniform expectation from September, which hasn't changed. We will be expecting all children to follow the uniform guidelines in September and be aware of the rules around jewellery, watches and long hair. We will also be strict when it comes to the PE kits as some children have started arriving in school with non-uniform kit.

Please read the uniform information carefully.

## **PE DAYS:**

As we have done this year, we ask children to come to school wearing their PE kits on their allocated PE days. Reception is just 1 day a week; KS1 is twice a week; KS2 will be once or twice a week depending on the time of year. Each class will provide that information to parents on Friday 2nd September – the first day of the new school year.

## **END OF YEAR:**

School will close at 1.00 pm on Wednesday 20th July, with After School Club closing at 3.00 pm.

Children will be bringing all their books home on Tuesday 19th July so could you please ensure you have sent in a carrier-bag by then.

As the school will be deep cleaned over the summer holiday, and tidied out, ALL items of uniform must be collected by close of school on Wednesday 20th. Any items remaining in school will be either disposed of or sent to charity. Please do ensure you ask your children to bring all their things home BEFORE we close; nothing else will be needed for the last few days of the summer term.

The lost property box is in the Work Room, next to the exit for Year 5 and 6. If you are looking for lost items, please feel free to check the box before or after school.
