FLU VACCINATION PROGRAMME

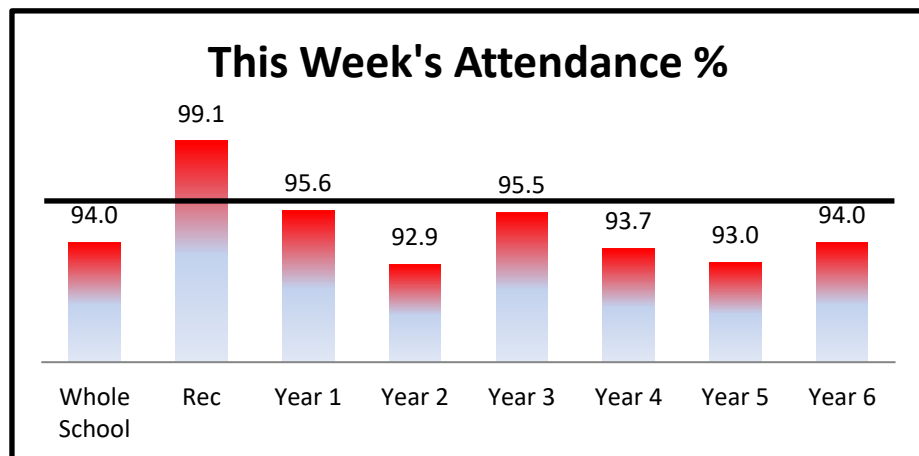
